



GEO&GEO VISITS REGINELLA D'ABRUZZO

The television programme on RAI 3 is dedicating a TV special on the historic dairy farm in Sulmona run by the D'Amico brothers and sister.

Cose dell'altro Geo, a TV programme on Rai 3 stops in at Sulmona and visits the historic dairy farm Reginella d'Abruzzo.

The well-known television programme that is part of the program Geo & Geo, covers topics ranging from animals to nature and gastronomy. And speaking about food, this time the entire TV programme staff, led by the young TV conductor **Massimiliano Ossini** has chosen to visit Reginella d'Abruzzo known for the excellence of its products in this sector. The television cameras of **Cose dell'altro Geo** have got in on the production of the famous fiordilatte. Together with the company administrator **Paolo D'Amico** they have filmed and commented on the whole producing process starting from the coagulation of milk that occurs thanks to the adding of rennet and enzymes, going through the "filature" and the shaping into individual cheeses, and ending with the packing of the final product. The inevitable final "tasting" with the whole company management concludes the programme.

Since the beginning of the 1900s the D'Amico family dairy farm produces the famous mozzarella and not only. Today the fourth generation, represented by **Paolo, Simone and Incoronata**, has taken over the reins of this historic company successfully combining traditional techniques and experience with modern
